3. Use unit consistent with instructions provided in this manual.




Battery Installation and First Time Setup

1. Remove the battery isolator tab that hangs from the battery compartment.
2. Your scale is set to default to pounds. To change the unit between pounds and kilograms press the UNIT button.
3. Replace the battery when low battery indicator displays.

Safe Weighing Operation

Important: For your safety **DO NOT** attempt to weigh luggage unless you can comfortably and safely lift it.

1. **Securely clip buckle around luggage handle.** Make sure buckle is secure and strap is properly adjusted.
2. **Hold scale.** Allow strap to dangle loosely below the scale or readings will not be accurate.
3. **Initialize the scale.** Press the ON/OFF button and wait for the unit to go to zero. If the unit does not go to zero press the ON/OFF button one time.
4. **Select your desired measurement unit.** Press the UNIT button to switch between lbs. and kgs.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter problems with your EatSmart Voyager please use the following tips for troubleshooting.

1. Check that your battery is properly installed with the polarity facing the proper direction.
2. Make sure the unit of measure has been correctly selected.
3. If the scale will not turn on or the battery indicator is lit, try inserting a new battery.
4. If O_Ld is displayed the scale has been overloaded and weight must be removed.

5. **Grip the scale firmly with two hands and lift your luggage.** Bend your knees and focus on lifting as steadily as possible without looking at the display. Avoid twisting your back or leaning forward.
6. **Wait for the beep.** The scale will beep once when a weight has been determined and display HOLD. Put down the luggage and read the weight. The scale will stay on for approximately 20 seconds before turning off automatically to conserve battery life.

Tips

1. We recommend your luggage weighs a minimum of one pound less than your airlines luggage allowance (i.e., 49 lbs. if your airlines max weight is 50 lbs.) This should allow you to pack your luggage scale to take with you.
2. If the strap is pulled taught while turning the scale on or taking a zero reading this will negatively affect the accuracy.
